PAYMENT OPTIONS/RECEIPTS FOR TUITION

All tuition fee payments are due the day the course begins. All payment or receipt inquiries are to be addressed to the Student Accounts Office at 902.867.2123/3738. Payments may be made online by setting up St. Francis Xavier University as a Payee and the account number is your StFX student ID number. Cheques are to be made payable to St. Francis Xavier University and please indicate your student ID number on the cheque.

Refunds

To drop a course please contact the Program Office by phone at 1.800.565.4371 or by email to distance.nursing@stfx.ca (we don't have a drop option on Banner). Please do not contact the Registrar's Office.

If a student withdraws from a course within three weeks of the course start date, s/he is eligible to claim a tuition refund, less a \$150 processing charge. After the three-week deadline has passed, there is no refund issued. Your application for a refund must be made in writing via email to the Program Office within the three-week period. Please include your StFX ID# and the name and number of the course.

Contacting your professor does not constitute formal withdrawal from a course and will not be considered in the calculation of a refund – you must follow the steps above.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING PROCTORS

Please note, this is a reminder our proctoring policies are changing in January 2020.

Courses that start in January 2020 and beyond will fall under the new policy. Courses that started in Fall 2019 will fall under the old policy.

Online exams:

Students are responsible for making proctoring arrangements and covering associated costs. The most straightforward way of arranging for a proctor is through **ProctorU**, an online proctoring service with which Continuing & Distance Education (CDE) has an agreement. **ProctorU** affords you the convenience of writing your exam within any room where you can be alone and undisturbed, as long as the room has reliable internet with adequate speed (e.g., your home office). Fees for using ProctorU are quite reasonable. Information on writing with **ProctorU** can be found in your course syllabus and your course Moodle site.

Alternatively, you must arrange for a proctor at a postsecondary educational institution, in which case you will write a paper exam.

<u>Paper exams:</u> Students are responsible for making proctoring arrangements and covering associated costs. Paper exams must be written at a **postsecondary educational institution or testing centre**. Workplace proctoring is no longer an option.
