Yeditepe University is a private foundation university situated in Istanbul, Turkey that offers its courses in English. Istanbul is the largest city in Turkey and the country's economic, cultural and historic center. The city straddles the Bosphorus strait, and lies in both Europe and Asia. Istanbul is the most populous city in Europe, and the world's fifteenth-largest city. The campus is located on the outskirts of Kayışdağı on the Asian Side of Istanbul, and is equipped with student club rooms, a large central library, residence halls, a cinema complex, two television studios, indoor and outdoor basketball courts, outdoor volleyball and tennis courts, indoor and outdoor half Olympic sized swimming pools, a fully equipped fitness and aerobics center, a shopping complex, and large grassy areas with benches and picnic facilities.

Details:	Lodgings on campus can accommodate 4400 students, with separate residence halls for men and women, conveniently located on the main campus. All rooms are double occupancy and provide private bathrooms, internet access, in-house snack bars, TV rooms, laundry facilities, visitor salons, and study lounges.

Health Insurance:	All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad which covers trip cancellation or interruption and emergency medical care (hospitalization, medical and paramedical expenses, medical evacuation, and repatriation). Link Additionally, the Turkish government requires exchange students to purchase insur- ance from a Turkish Company or a Canadian company that has branches in Turkey. Your Insurance Policy Documents must be in Turkish. Link	
Living Expenses:	Link	
Visa:	Canadian exchange students will require a residence permit to study abroad in Tur- key. The residence permit is applied for AFTER arrival in Turkey, students will give their documents to Yeditepe's International Erasmus Office, and the office will apply for the permit on the student's behalf. Link The necessary documents are as follows: Online Application Form (You will prepare this form after your arrival), Passport Photocopy - The Identity Page and the page that shows your arrival date/stamp, 4 Photos (Please bring them with you and write your name at the back of each photo), Student Certification (Yeditepe Universi- ty will provide this document after your arrival), Residence Permit Card Payment Receipt (Payment is made after your arrival), Health Insurance (In Turkish), Address Information Sheet. The cost is 75-100 Tukrish Lira (\$10-15 CAD). Students will also need to apply for an E-Visa to enter turkey. This can be applied for online and will be sent to the student via email when complete (\$105 CAD). Link
