Course Requirements:	Exchange students are expected to take 60 UK credits per semester of study. 60 UK credits are equal to 15 credits at StFX. 10 UK credits are equal to 3 credits at StFX.
Course Restrictions:	Incoming students can choose modules (courses) across all academic areas, subject to approval. Most of LTU's degree courses are 3 years in duration. When selecting modules (courses), you need to be aware of the academic level to ensure you are studying at a level in keeping with your studies at home. 3rd year StFX students will typically choose year 1 or year 2 modules. Year 3 modules would be equivalent to 4th year courses at StFX.

Cost:	£400 - £556 per month. (Equivalent to approximately \$690 - \$960 CAD)
Details:	Leeds Trinity University offers eight different on campus accommodation options of varying cost, size, and available facilities. On campus residences include electricity, heating and water, regular cleaning, free WiFi access, and food allowances depending on the type of accommodation.

Health Insurance:	All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad. Link Additionally, full-year exchange students to the U.K. will be required to pay an immigration health surcharge (£470) as part of their student visa application fee.
